Historically farmers and local gardeners have created and sustained this rich genetic heritage by learning to save their own seeds from varieties that perform best in their own mini-ecosystems. The current trend toward mono crops where only one seed type is used to produce a crop worldwide is eliminating the ability to be able to find genetic variations that will withstand emerging pathogens and climate changes. SELECTION OF SITE AND SEED

The best flower garden/meadow results will be obtained on a project site that is free of weeds, sunlit, level, and well drained. However, project sites rarely have all of these qualities. Wildflowers and wildflower/grass mixtures often grow better in poor quality soil and, can withstand drought conditions. The best seed mixture should be selected based on the unique properties of the project site, including its geographic region, exposure/sun (aspect), slope, availability of moisture, and residential codes. Roadsides, heavy use or urban areas may require a low-growing mix that has a natural look while maintaining a shorter profile. Other mixes are specially blended to include species that attract birds, hummingbirds, butterflies and bees. Project sites in dry (xeric) areas require species that thrive during times of drought. Special consideration must be taken to ensure that the project site will have adequate moisture during germination and the first growing season. Beauty Beyond Belief's high guality seeds are carefully chosen based on purity and viability standards and include no fillers or inert materials. We create our wildflower mixes for the growing conditions in specific regions based on geography, elevation, rainfall, humidity, and annual temperature range. These mixes include annuals, perennials, native, and introduced species to establish a strong stand and provide an extensive range of bloom time and color. The annuals included in our mixes provide vibrant color, soil stability, shade and quard against weed invasion for the slower growing perennial species. Some annuals may re-seed and return for a few more seasons. The perennials will bloom during the second and following years.

WHEN TO PLANT

Climate (especially rainfall) should be used to determine the optimum time for seeding the project site. Plant just before the beginning of the rainy season if there will be no supplemental irrigation, usually that is spring, after the last frost date. Check with the local Agriculture Extension Office or Natural Resources Conservation Service Office for the average 'last frost date' in the project site area. With supplemental irrigation, wildflowers and mixes can be planted through spring and into early summer up to 9-10 weeks before the first fall frost. Late fall is also a great time to plant allowing seeds to overwinter and sprout during the next spring. Seeds may be planted during the winter when the ground is workable and where temperatures remain below freezing. Fall and winter plantings are appropriate for areas that will not receive supplemental irrigation but will rely on the subsequent spring rainy season. In mild climates where there is no chance of freezing, plant in the fall before periods of expected rainfall.

SITE PREPARATION

The success of your wildflower garden is dependent on your preparation and weed control. Proper planning will bring hardy, long lasting beauty. Aggressive choking grasses should be removed. Eliminate all weeds. A good way to do this is to cover the ground with black plastic cloth to bake out the existing GROW. ENJOY. SHARE.

weeds, or better yet, allow weeds to germinate and then shallowly till under. Tilling the soil deeper may promote the germination of dormant weed seeds present in the topsoil. Doing this several times will get rid of the weed seeds in the top few inches of soil. If no weeds are present, the soil should be only lightly tilled if hard packed; otherwise, roughen the surface to promote good seed to soil contact. Soil amendments and fertilizers are probably unnecessary and fertilizer will promote weed growth and compromise bloom time. A low nitrogen fertilizer may be used on excessively poor soils.

PLANTING METHODS

Follow the suggested planting rates and methods for the wildflower seed species and wildflower mixes that are printed on each package label and can be found on our website under 'Wildflower Tips'.

SITE MAINTENANCE

Maintenance and weed control are essential to the creation and propagation of a luxurious wildflower display. Quickly growing, vigorous annuals in the seed mix will provide shade for the slow growing perennials and can suppress weed growth. Pull weeds as soon as they are identified or cut them off so they will not produce seed. The project site should fill in over the following years as the perennial wildflowers becoming established. Annuals will often re-seed themselves. Additional seeding may be needed for bare spots or to achieve the original colorful display of annuals. Mow to a height of 6 inches in the late fall after the seeds have matured and the leaves have turned brown, thrashing the seed pods to scatter the seeds for next year's germination.

ADDING NATIVES TO YOUR LANDSCAPE

Wildflowers are some of the greatest treasures of nature. A native wildflower or indigenous species are those flowers (forbs) that originate from a defined geographical area and have adapted, through natural selection, to the regional environmental conditions. These spectacular plant species are naturally suited to grow in specific regions, and offer many benefits that introduced or exotic species don't offer. Once established, native wildflowers require less water, fertilizer, and pest control because they have adapted to survive without the supplemental care usually needed by introduced or exotic species. So, how do you go about finding out what is native in your area, and what's not? Your local University Agricultural Extension Office will have a detailed list of native forbs (wildflowers). Another option is to contact your state's native plant society. Next, check the species available in our catalog and our website at www.bbbseed.com, to find the available natives for your area.





An introduced, cool season, perennial legume used as hay, pasture and soil improvement and for honey bee and bumble bee forage. Adapted to a wide range of soil types, good for northern areas and high elevations. Prefers silty clay loams with consistent moisture (18 " plus or irrigation). Not shade tolerant. Usually sown as 25% of a mix with flowers. Height: 2-4 feet.

Seeding Rate: 1/8 lb per 1000 sq ft; 2-4 lbs. per acre



A cool-season, drought tolerant, biennial legume used as a ground cover, soil builder, cover crop, for erosion control, and in pasture mixtures and a great source of pollen and nectar. Prefers well drained, fertile soils, but will tolerate clay soils. Do not mow during the first year as it will bloom the second year and then die. Spring seeded sweet clover may be plowed under in the fall or winter of the first year to build organic matter and boost nitrogen levels.

A cool-season perennial legume used as a ground cover, cover crop, for erosion control, and in pasture mixtures. Often used in lawn seed mixes as it is quick to sprout and provides soil stabilization and nutrients for the lawn grasses. It has a creeping growth habit and spreads with rhizomes or "runners". Height: 6 - 8 inches. Seed alone or into an existing grass stand. Prefers well-drained, fertile soils, but will tolerate clay soils. Can be mowed.

American Vetch

Vicia americana



A native, perennial legume that forms a single vining stem with climbing tendrils and clusters of purple flowers, growing 1 to 2 feet tall (long). Spreads through rhizomes and reseeds well. Very drought tolerant and excellent for sunny and partially shady locations. Use as part of a wildlife seed mix with native grasses and wildflowers or a spring cover crop for soil improvement and stabilization. Excellent for grazing and hay and forage for native pollinators. Use as a native alternative for crown vetch for landscaping. Direct sow in the fall.

Seeding Rate: For cover crop: 15-20 lbs vetch per 50 lbs rye or 10 lbs per acre

Hairy Vetch

Vicia villosa



A naturalized, cool season, annual or biennial vetch from Europe having thin branched stems up to 5 feet long, fuzzy leaves and violet/rose to white flower clusters. It prefers fertile loam soils, but is also productive on sandy or clay soils and a fairly shallow root system. Hairy Vetch is used as erosion control, green manure, cover crop, silage or hay and it can provide substantial amounts of nitrogen and dry matter to the soil. Great for spring weed suppression especially mixed with cereal grains such as Winter Rye. Direct sow in the fall.

Seeding Rate: 30-40 lbs per acre; 1¼ lbs per 1000 sq ft

Utah Sweetvetch

Hedysarum boreale



Also called Northern Sweetvetch, a native, perennial, cool season, legume with deep taproots making it drought tolerant and winter hardy. Great for soil stabilization and rangeland seedings, nutritious for livestock and wildlife, an important habitat for sage grouse and great forage for pollinators. One of the few native legumes available to use for reclamation with great ability to fix nitrogen. Purple, pink or white flowers arranged in a loose raceme top woody stems with basil leaves. Plant in early spring or, late fall.
